Types of childcare available

Nanny

Nannies are professional (qualified and/or experienced) childcare specialists who are responsible for providing children with a safe and stimulating environment in which to support their physical, social, emotional, creative and intellectual development.

The nanny plays a major role in supporting the family structure, leaving busy parents with the opportunity to spend their evenings and weekends with their children uninterrupted by household and childcare chores.

Nanny duties

- To provide flexible and individual care. Nannies can pay greater attention to your children's needs.
- To protect your children from any harm, providing them with a safe environment in which to develop.
- To prepare nutritionally balanced meals for your family.
- To maintain good communication, informing you of your children's development or of any concerns in behaviour.
- To help with tasks such as taking your children to and from school, to after school activities, organising play-dates, helping with homework, carrying out laundry duties and running errands.

Nanny share

Sharing a nanny with another family is a great way to cut down on nanny costs.

Advantages of a nanny share

- Your children receive individual care.
- Your children get a playmate, making it a more sociable solution.
- You get the flexibility of a nanny at manageable costs.

Au pair

Au pairs are foreign-national childcare assistants, working for and living with host families. Typically, au pairs are young women (between the ages of 18 and 27 years old) who take on a share of the family's childcare responsibilities and light housework duties, and who receive board and pocket-money allowance in return. The au pair is intended to become a member of the family, both parties benefiting and learning about the other's culture.

Summer au pair

Babysitter

Maternity nurse

Maternity nurses provide expert services (either live-in or live-out) and advice in all areas of infant care, especially with sleep routines, handling and settling of the baby, feeding and breast feeding, weight gain patterns, maintaining good hygiene and managing nursery duties (including keeping the nursery clean and tidy and doing the baby's laundry).

Tutor

A tutor is a private educator, usually with a teaching background, who is responsible for a child's social, creative and intellectual development.

The tutor can pay individual attention to a student's needs, allowing them to improve knowledge and skills far more rapidly than in a classroom environment.
